Statute of Limitations: Later of 2 years from injury or last payment of benefits. Occupational Disease: 2 years from date causal connection made between disease and occupational exposure. 3 years if ER fails to file Report of Injury.

Report of Injury: File with Division within 30 days of knowledge of accident that requires medical aid or compensation.

Notice of Injury: Employee must report within 30 days of accident. Occupational Disability report within 30 days employee reasonably aware of work relatedness.

Answer: Must be filed by attorney within 30 days of Division acknowledgment of receipt of Claim. Failure to file timely answer results in acceptance of facts plead in claim.

Repetitive Trauma: work must be the prevailing factor causing both the medical condition and disability. If exposure is less than 3 months, prior employer may be liable.

Subrogation: "Ruediger" Formula (WC paid / gross 3rd party recovery) x (net 3rd party recovery) = subrogation amount due ER/IR.

AWW: Gross earnings / number of weeks worked in 13 weeks prior to accident. Gratuity and overtime is included.

PPD: 2/3 AWW up to maximum for accident date. *Minimum* \$40.00/week. *Part-time* workers use "30 hour rule." *Minors* require consideration of increased earning power.

TTD: 2/3 AWW up to maximum for accident date. *Minimum* \$40.00/week. *Maximum* payment of 400 weeks. *Waiting period:* 3 business days, but if loss of + 14 days, waiting period paid to employee. *Ends* with MMI or termination for post-injury misconduct.

TPD: 2/3 difference between pre-accident wage and wage employee should be able to earn post accident. *Ends* with MMI. *Maximum* payment of 100 weeks.

PTD: 2/3 AWW up to maximum for accident date. Inability to return to any employment in open labor market. *Second Injury Fund* may have liability for PTD (Employer only liability for current injury disability) when current disability combines with minimum prior disability to make employee PTD.

Death: Total dependents receive lifetime benefits of 2/3 AWW up to maximum for accident date. *Burial Benefit:* \$5,000.00.

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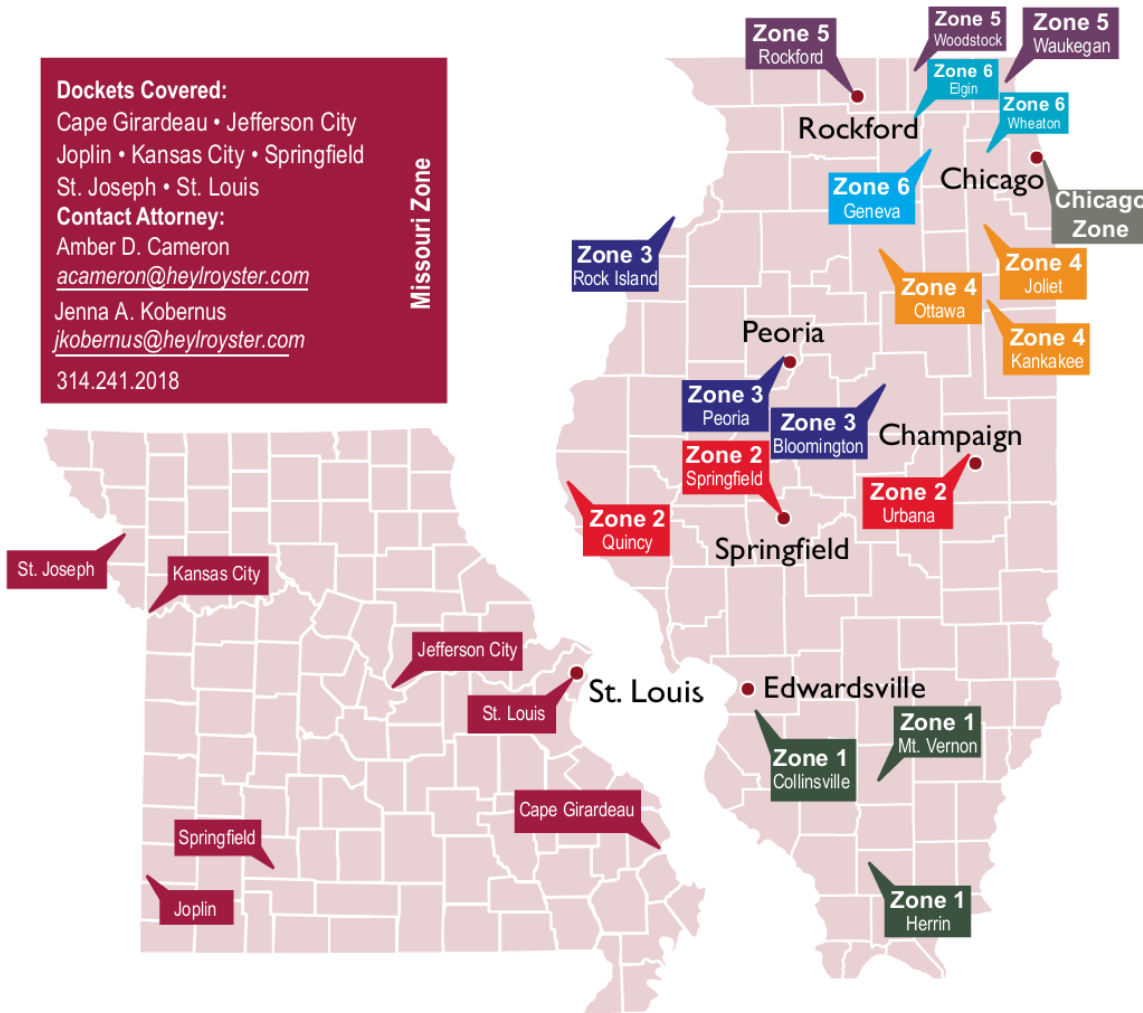
